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# ITINERARY

## DAY 1: TASHKENT arrival



Meet & Assist of Tashkent Airport meet driver, transfer to hotel and leave luggage (check-in at/after 14:00).

- 09:00 meet the guide at hotel and start city tour to Tashkent and visits:
- Visit Khast-i-Imam complex (reconstructed in 2007), religious center of Tashkent. Architectural ensemble includes several constructions, built in XVI -XIX cc.
- Madrasa Kukeldash, Juma Mosque and Chorsu Bazaar the country's biggest market.
- Afternoon: visit The Museum of Applied Art of Tashkent, the ancient palace of Russian diplomat Alexander Polovtsev that is transformed to the museum in 1938.
- City tour to Amir Temur Square, Independence Square and Minor Mosque.
- Overnight at hotel.

# DAY 2: TASHKENT - URGENCH - KHIVA (domestic flight)



- Breakfast then transfer to airport to take domestic flight to Urgench. (HY 055| 07h40 09h20 | subject to change).
- Arrival at the airport of URGENCH, meet the driver at the Airport and transfer to KHIVA.
- On arrival, transfer to hotel and leave luggage (check-in at/after 14:00).
- Explore marvelous city, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Sightseeing program includes excursion in all monuments of Ichan Kala. Ichan Kala is the inner town (protected by brick walls some 10 m high) of the old Khiva oasis, which was the last resting-place of caravans before crossing the desert to Iran.

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- Although few very old monuments still remain, it is a coherent and well-preserved example of the Muslim architecture of Central Asia: Juma Mosque, constitutes remarkable type of architecture of XVII cc.;
- Kunya Ark: 'ancient fortress' established in 1686 1688 by Arang-Khan; to south of Kunya Ark were found Kalta Minor and the Medresa of Muhammad-Amin-Khan; The Tash-Kauli Palace, built in 1830 - 1838 for Alla-Kulli-Khan, (whose name means 'slave of God', he was blissfully unaware of the plans being put into place in Russia for a massive invasion).
- PM: explore other exceptional monuments in Ichan Kala: Mausoleum of Pahlavan Mahmud (1247 1325); Mausoleum of Sayid All-Uddin; Medresa of Islam-Khodja with its elegant minaret, at 45 m the highest in Khiva; Medresa of Alla-Kuli.
- Overnight at hotel.

### DAY 3: KHIVA - BUKHARA (450 KM ~7-8H DRIVE)



- Breakfast, then drive in the early morning to BUKHARA direction by passing red sands of the desert Kizil-Kum ... road crossing the arid steppe with herds of sheep of astrakhan.
- A Pause and explore the river of Amu-Darya, blue serpent in the desert...en-route near Gazli.
- Arrival late afternoon, transfer and check-in and overnight at the hotel.

#### **DAY 4: BUKHARA**



Breakfast, then meet your guide, and journey to the mysterious Silk Road City of Bukhara and its magnificent historical monuments.





- Full day sightseeing program includes the visits to: Architectural complex Poi-Kalyan (means «Foot of the Great»), consisting of 3 constructions built in XII-XVI centuries: Madrasah Miri-Arab, mosque and Minaret Kalyan (main complex decoration);
- Madrasa Of Ulug Beg and Abdulaziz Khan which marks the remarkable progress of medieval Central Asian architecture; Tim Abdullah Khan a covered bazaar built in 1577;
- Magok-i Attari Mosque (Museum of Carpets) is one of the oldest architectural monuments where you will find heathen shrines, remains of a Buddhist monastery, Zoroastrian Temple in Bukhara.
- PM: Explore other monuments: architectural ensemble Laybi-Hauz (means «the shore of reservoir»), consisting of 3 monumental buildings: Kukeldash Madrassa and 2 other religious buildings: Hanaka and Madrasah of Nadir Divan-Begi; Ark Citadel residence of Bukhara khans, a massive fortress built and occupied around the 5<sup>th</sup> century AD. Bolo-Hauz Mosque, built in the 17<sup>th</sup> century, was a place of prayer for the Emirs and their entourage. It is the only preserved monument in Registan Square that includes: multi-column aivan, domed mosque, minaret and a small pool; the mausoleum of Ismail Samani, one of the most ancient monuments in the city, mausoleum Chashma Ayub, or "Source of Job". Overnight at hotel.

### DAY 5: BUKHARA -SHAKHRISABZ -SAMARKAND (264 km ~ 4 h drive)



- Breakfast at hotel. In the morning drive to SAMARKAND via SHAKHRISABZ CITY.
- Stop in Shakhrisabz and enjoy the city sightseeing tour: Visit the Mausoleum of Jakhongir in Dor Saodat Memorial Complex, remains of Ak-Saray Palace, Dor-ut Tilavat Ensemble with Kok-Gumbaz Mosque; and burial vault of Tamerlane's father.
- In the afternoon drive to SAMARKAND. Upon arrival, transfer and check-in to the hotel. Overnight at hotel.









- Breakfast at hotel. In the morning sightseeing tour in SAMARKAND: Registan Square ("Sandy Place"), the ensemble of 3 madrasahs (Ulughbek Madrasah (1417-1420), Sher Dor Madrasah (1619-1636), and Tillya Kori Madrasah (1646-1660) a unique example of town-building art, remarkable architectural planning of the main town square;
- The Gur-Amir Mausoleum a world known masterpiece of Central Asian architecture, the family crypt of the great dynasty of Tamerlane, with a fine ribbed dome and decorated with paper-maché inside.
- In the afternoon, explore other miracles in the city: The **Pearl of Samarkand;** and
- Bibi Khanum Mosque. Constructed in 1399 by the best architects and artisans of Khorossan, Azerbaijan, Persia and India, the mosque was compared to the beauty and shining of the Milky Way;
- Siyab Bazar -the most ancient and the biggest traditional market of Samarkand.
- In the evening you will take a visit to the theatre of historical costume "El Merosi". "El Merosi" in uzbek means "The Peoples' Heritage". The theatre shows the traditions of local people, existing from ancient time to present, and the national costumes of different epochs: leather suits of Scythian horsemen, costume of Achemenians made of gold brocade, suits of Anahita made of the finest fabrics, hats made of woven silver, suit of a Sogdian, made of fabric decorated with hand-embroidery. Overnight at hotel.

#### DAY 7: SAMARKAND -TASHKENT (train express)



- Breakfast at hotel, then meet the guide. Explore other historical sites of Samarkand:
- Shakhi-Zinda ensemble with more than 20 buildings, built from early XI up to XIV cc. Each mausoleum has its own style of decoration and great fantasy of skillful artisans;

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


- **Observatory of Ulugbek**, the first observatory in Central Asia, built in XIV c.
- Hodja Daniyar Mausoleum, located near the healing spring and attracts crowds of tourists every day. Some believe that Daniel was biblical prophet others associate him with fellow-soldier of Kusam ibn Abbas.
- In the afternoon, visit to Afrasiab Museum.
- 16:30: transfer to railway station, we take the fast speed train to Tashkent at 17:00. Arrival in Tashkent at 19:10, transfer and check-at the hotel, and overnight.

#### Day 8 Tashkent - departure

Transfer to the International Airport, 2 or 3 hours before departure.
